

## 2022 BOUGETZ CELLARS ARDANTE MOUNT VEEDER CABERNET SAUVIGNON


## WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2022 Ardante Mount Veeder Cabernet
Sauvignon is composed of 96% Cabernet
Sauvignon and 4% Merlot. Sourced from the
Yates Family Vineyard, located near the summit of
Mount Veeder, this wine showcases the distinctive
characteristics of mountain-grown fruit. Its deep
purple/ruby color is accompanied by an aromatic
profile of black fruits. Full-bodied, it features
flavors of blackberries and black cherries, and
spice. Patience will be rewarded with vibrant, ageworthy wine.

## HARVEST NOTES

The 2022 growing season began relatively normally, leading to an early start to the harvest. However, in late September, we faced a 10-day stretch of temperatures exceeding 100°F, which caused sugar levels in early-ripening reds to spike, resulting in some lots being out of balance. Fortunately, the later-ripening lots were unaffected, ripening only about a week earlier than anticipated. Harvest took place at night of October 16th.
